Instead of two stewards being on duty every Sunday, one steward will be able to be responsible for the difficult or daunting tasks, if they have the support of another member of the church family to do some of the routine jobs like adding the hymn numbers, unlocking the side gates, making sure there is water for the preacher etc...

We are sure that very many people in the church would help in this way: the more volunteers we have, the less often the job comes round - perhaps just one Sunday each quarter, so that those actively involved in leading the church can have some space to develop our work. **PLEASE** give this some serious thought, and if you would like to help in this way, please let one of the stewards know, or speak to one of them if you want to find out a little more about what might be involved.
